

SOACP Module 23: SOA Quality Assurance Lab

As a continuation of course modules 21 and 22, this hands-on workshop enables attendees to apply SOA quality assurance practices first hand, via a series of exercises, in order to solve a number of interrelated problems. Both individual and group exercises are provided. Lab exercises focus on the identification of common problem areas within shared services and service-oriented solutions, and further require participants to apply quality assurance and testing techniques in order to counter problems, while further guiding services and solutions through processes designed to help them meet specific certification criteria for production-ready deployment. Participants are also required to create test plans in response to specific performance, reliability and availability requirements.

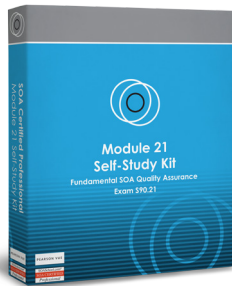
